Description of Work Utility Improvements

Description of work and anticipated impacts

As part of the 2023 Pavement Management Project, utility improvements will be conducted throughout the project. Utility Improvements will consist of replacement of various storm sewer structures, water main hydrants, and sanitary sewer structures. The utility improvements will only directly impact some residences throughout the project. If you are receiving this notice your address is one of the residences that will be impacted during the utility improvement work.

To complete the replacement of the utility features noted above the contractor will have to complete excavation of the boulevard area behind the curb. Any private features that you wish to save within the anticipated excavation limits should be protected as noted below. The anticipated limits of disturbance required to complete the utility work that will extends behind the curb will be marked out with *pink paint*. All disturbed areas will be restored with topsoil and seeded later in the year after construction is complete. Protecting your sprinkler systems, invisible fence, and landscaping

If you wish to protect your private features from damage during construction, please temporarily remove them from the City right of way area that will be impacted by construction (about 3-5ft behind the curb marked for removal). Sprinkler heads can be disconnected, and the hose can be dug up and pulled back. Spot curb areas will have white areas painted on curb marked for removal. Please protect features within this area. Please protect features behind the entire length of curb in full-curb removal areas.

Any damage to private features in the right of way will not be repaired, replaced, or altered by the city or the contractor.
