Report Illicit Discharge

What is It?

An **illicit discharge** is anything that enters a storm drain that is *not* rain or snow melt. Illicit discharges are water pollution.

Why Does it Matter?

Anything entering a storm drain isn't sent for treatment but instead drains directly into waterbodies such as lakes and rivers.

Most Frequent Offenders

These should never go down a storm drain!
