Dates

For the week of June 29th to July 3rd, sanitary sewer and water will continue on Scenic River Drive from Mississippi Road to Forestview Drive and on Mississippi Road from Scenic River Drive to Forestview Drive.

On Camwood Trail from Scenic River Drive to the storm sewer outfall to the Mississippi River and on Scenic River Drive from Mississippi Road north to unimproved Camwood Trail the Contractor will be grading the street and ditches and placing one lift of class 5.

RL Larson is bringing a crushing machine to their stock yard on the north side of Highland Scenic Road between TH 371 and Forestview Drive to produce class 5.

Private utility companies (gas, electric, and communications) will continue to relocate their infrastructure.

- Xcel Energy will be working on Laredo Road. They will be installing new gas mains such that there are mains on both sides of the street and reconnecting services to eliminate services crossing the street.

See the map attached at the end of this newsletter for these areas highlighted in red and labeled.

RL Larson anticipates installing sewer and water on Camwood Trail from the lift station north towards Highland Scenic Road the week of July 6th.

July 4th Weekend

RL Larson will not be working on Friday, July 3rd.



Access

The Contractor has planned working hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. During underground utility installations pipe is planned to be constructed until at least 7:00 p.m. and backfilling of trenches completed thereafter. With the magnitude of the project the contractor is looking to maximize the available daylight during June and July to finish the project on time. With the depth of the excavations backfilling and cleaning up the site in a safe manner will entail equipment running until around 8:30 pm.

Local traffic will be allowed to use the affected streets to gain access to businesses and their homes during construction. There may be periods when you will not have access to your driveway when utility trenches are open directly in front of your property. The Contractor and Inspector will coordinate with property owners when access will be limited to their property.

The Contractor will work with the postmaster and garbage haulers to establish temporary locations during construction. You will be contacted in the future regarding location and timing for these services during construction. **Please have your garbage containers at the end of your driveways the night before your scheduled garbage pick-up. This will help the Contractor get the containers to the temporary locations.**

Access will be maintained for emergency vehicles.

Construction

It is very common on these types of projects that area residents (especially children) become quite curious about the work the Contractor is performing. We ask that you please be respectful of and stay well clear of construction zones. Many hazards and dangers exist from heavy machinery, trenches, loose material, confined spaces, hot asphalt, etc. and often times are not recognizable by the general public. The Contractor has responsibility to ensure safety on the project and within the construction area. Any direction from the Contractor regarding safety must be heeded; likewise if you observe an unsafe condition please report it to the Alex immediately.

Individuals present on the construction site must also follow guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Minnesota Department of Health related to COVID-19. The Contractor and Engineer have protocols in place to adhere to hygiene and social distancing recommendations.

 **Alerts****Service Line Connections**

Sewer and water services will be constructed as close as possible to your property line as part of the city project. Homeowners will be responsible for hiring a contractor to abandon or remove the existing septic system and make the sewer and water connections between the property line and the house.

Even if you are not planning to connect to City utilities this year please be in touch with an excavating contractor to plan the route for your services from your house to the right-of-way. This coordination is critical for you to understand potential impacts to your property and installation and restoration costs. Attached is the list of excavators certified with the City of Baxter.

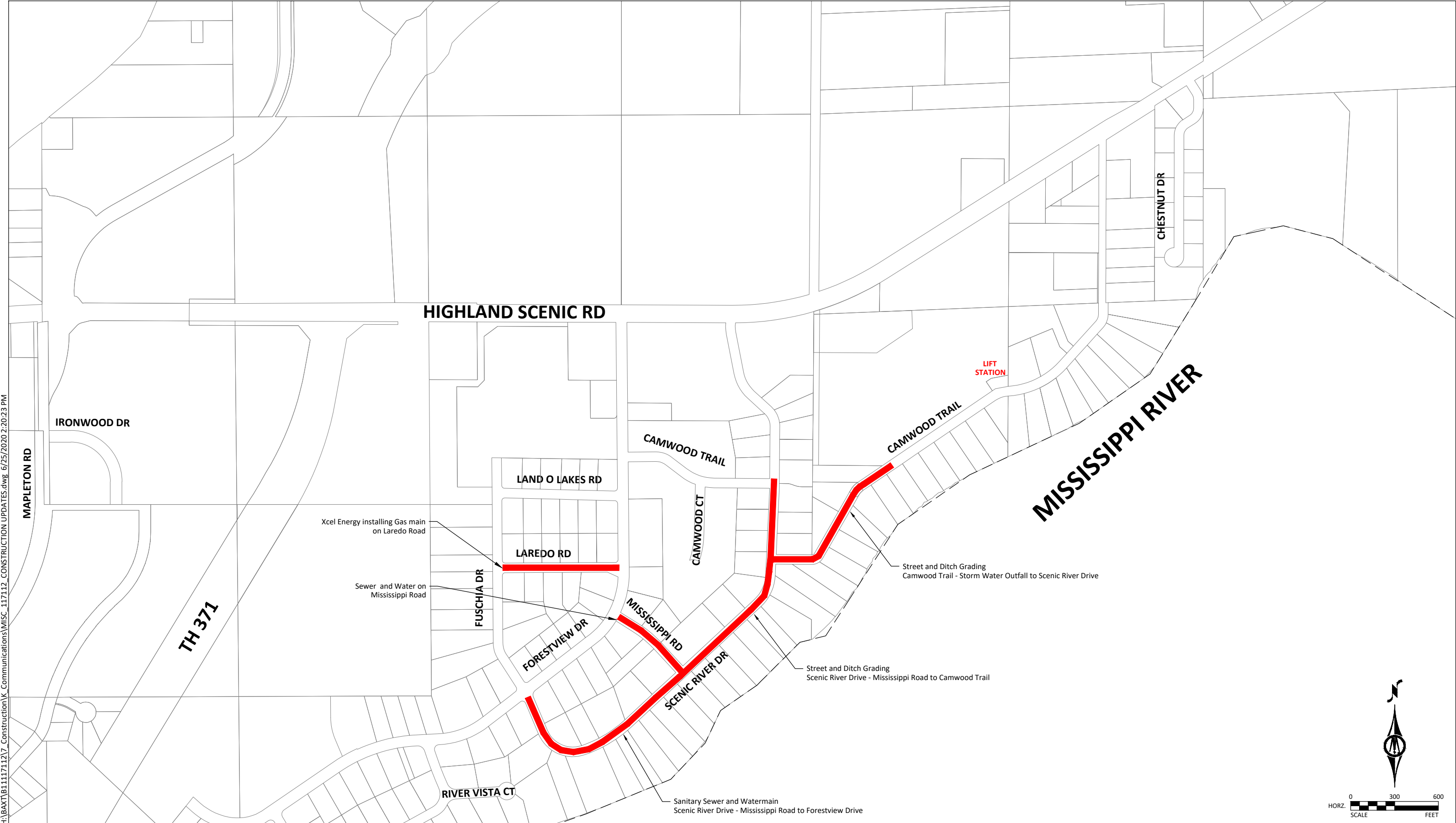

Private Improvements in Right-of-Way

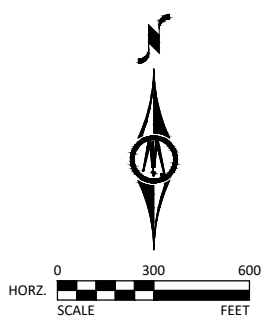
If you have improvements such as landscaping, retaining walls, shrubs, bushes, flowers, sheds, irrigation systems, etc. in the right-of-way, it is not the contractor's responsibility to work around them. The property owner is responsible for securing these private improvements and moving them if necessary, to allow the project to be constructed. Neither the contractor nor City is responsible for damages incurred to private improvements in the right-of-way. Any underground improvements, such as irrigation lines and heads, dog fences, etc., should be located and marked so they are readily visible.
