The Sailor Street project has been underway for roughly a month now and construction progress has been moving along nicely. Dirt Merchant will be done with the underground utilities in Phase 1 by the middle of next week, weather permitting. As of now, Dirt Merchant's underground crew is planning to start installing underground utilities in Phase 2 next week once Phase 1 is complete. In preparation of this, Dirt Merchant will have a grading crew onsite next Monday, June 8th to remove gravel on 5th Street and Sailor Street from 5th Street to 4th Street.

While Dirt Merchants underground crew starts working in Phase 2, a separate grading crew will be onsite to subcut and shape the streets disturbed in Phase 1. Once the street is subcut, the crew will install drain tile lines. The tile will be located 1 foot behind the new curb to aid in removal of subsurface moisture. Each home will have a sump pump service outlet tied into the new drain tile. The sump pump line will be stubbed out 5 feet from back of curb or to the back side of sidewalk if present. Ben Rosol with Bolton & Menk will be coming around to talk with the homeowners to decide where to put these sump pump service outlets. Once the tile is installed, gravel base will be placed over the clay subgrade. After the gravel base is placed, access will be restored to your driveways and the streets will be reopened to local traffic only. This work should be completed in a few weeks, weather permitting.
