### Project Status

Dirt Merchant's underground crew has now completed the installation of all underground utilities in Phase 2 and started work in Phase 3. DMI's grading crew is currently working on restoring the streets disturbed in Phase 2. Once drain tile lines are installed on 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Sailor from 5<sup>th</sup> Street to 4<sup>th</sup> Street, gravel base will be placed over the clay subgrade. After the gravel base is placed, access will be restored to your driveways and the streets will be reopened to local traffic only.

Nielsen Concrete will begin concrete curb, driveway and sidewalk improvements along 6<sup>th</sup> Street starting on Monday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. Nielsen Concrete will be onsite all next week and will try to finish curb, driveways, and sidewalk installation along 6<sup>th</sup> Street. Nielsen Concrete will then need to leave for a few weeks for other project demands. Once Nielsen comes back, Phase 2 should be ready for concrete work as well. Check out the project website for information on what to expect during concrete construction.

As always, we appreciate your patience during construction, and we will do our best to keep you up to date with the construction progress and changes. Should any questions or concerns arise during the construction process, please contact Ben Rosol with Bolton & Menk at the phone number listed.



We kindly ask that residents along 6<sup>th</sup> St, have their vehicles out of the driveway by 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning. All residents will be able to continue using 6<sup>th</sup> Street throughout the remainder of the project. When construction is being conducted during the day, we ask that you park far enough away from your driveway that the workers have enough room to pour the curb, driveways, and sidewalk.
