Dear Local Residents and Business Owners,

Construction of the City of Bloomington's Penn-American Linear Stormwater Storage project is scheduled to start soon! You will be able to sign up for project update emails and track project progress at the project's website: www.BloomingtonPennAmerican.com. Please sign up today!

What work is being done?

The project includes new storm sewer pipes along Knox Avenue; establishing underground stormwater storage under the future 80½ Street between Morgan Circle and Knox Avenue; establishing underground stormwater storage east of the City's water reservoirs along 82nd Street; a large diameter pipe connecting the underground stormwater storage systems; and a large diameter pipe along the north side of 82nd Street extending into the intersection of Penn Avenue and 82nd Street. The project will decrease the magnitude, frequency, and duration of temporary flooding around the intersection of Knox Avenue and American Boulevard, improve runoff water quality to Penn Lake, and significantly improve public safety. How am I going to be impacted?

Knox Avenue between American Blvd and 81st Street will be fully closed for a portion of the project this summer and fall. Expect other streets in the area to be partially torn-up during the underground construction, please be mindful of traffic control changes and barriers. Updates on road closures will be posted on the project website. *Please visit the website and sign up for updates!*

What is the project schedule?

Work on the project is scheduled to start at the intersection of Penn Avenue and 82nd Street on July 30th. You will see construction signage and barricades set up ahead of time. While there will be some lane restrictions through the intersection, the intersection will remain open. Work will continue along the north side of 82nd Street through August and September, however the road will remain open. In mid to late August, additional work will begin in the American Boulevard and Knox Avenue intersection. Knox Avenue will be closed shortly after this work begins. The remainder of the project will continue until completed in Spring 2019.
