Notice of Construction Start Up State Street (CSAH 6)

The construction on State Street (CSAH 6) from the east side of N Willow Street to the east side of N Chestnut Street will begin today, **Friday, May 3rd**. The initial operations within this two-block area will include saw cutting for removals and installation of the temporary water system. Following the reclaiming yesterday, the roadway will remain open to local traffic from the west side of N Meridian Street until the work progression requires closure. The Contractor's schedule weather-dependent anticipates closure from the west side of N Meridian Street to the east side of N Chestnut St within the next two weeks to allow for the removal of the reclaim and installation of the new underground utilities.


The City's contractor Ryan Contracting plans to begin installation of the temporary water system along State Street between N Willow Street and Walnut Street (TH 25). The process involves a blue water pipe running along State St within each boulevard. Then off this pipe is a smaller water pipe that runs up to each home. The Contractor then connects this smaller pipe to a hose spigot located on the outside of each home/business. The actual connections to temporary water are not planned until late next week or the week after and will only include the properties between N Willow Street and N Chestnut Street at this time. To complete the connection, the contractor Ryan Contracting will be stopping by your home/business or leaving a note to schedule a meeting time to prepare your home/business for temporary water.

During construction, the contractor will be responsible for maintaining all garbage and recycling services. Please bring your cans to the edge of your property as you normally would on your respective pickup day and the contractor will ensure the containers are picked up. If desired, you can mark your specific cans to ensure they are properly returned.

State Street between N
Meridian Street and Walnut
Street (TH 25) will be
delivered to a temporary
mailbox location as noted
in the map to the right.
