Private Water & Sewer Service Improvements

If you own property in the Downtown project area and are thinking about making some changes during 2023 construction project, this information is for you. If you are considering adding/replacing service lines, installing fire suppression connections, relocating restrooms, increasing building occupancy load, etc. you should take action now.

Private property owners will be responsible for hiring a contractor to replace the sewer and water service outside of the right of way and for any plumbing work inside the building. The City's Contractor will not complete any work on private property. Property owners can work with any licensed plumber and a list of local contractors can be found on the left panel for reference.

Project Timeline

Any property owner interested in private service improvements is encouraged to follow these steps:

- 1. Call Cory Bienfang, Project Engineer, 507-995-2936 if you haven't already.
- 2. Hire a licensed contractor of your choice to complete the improvements on private property.
- 3. Submit a complete plumbing permit application to the City. <u>Plumbing</u> <u>permit fees may be waived.</u>
- 4. City Building Inspections will review and approve permit application.
- 5. City will share approved permit with Cory Bienfang who will then reach out to the property owner to discuss estimated construction timeline.

ONotice of Roadway Closure & Construction Start Up

Road closures and the start of construction will begin on Monday, April 24th. Initial operations will include the following streets:

- N Meridian St between State St and Main St
- Church St between Willow St and Chestnut St

All intersections will remain open except for intersection of Meridian and Church St which will be closed to vehicle traffic. No work within the alleys is planned at this time.

All businesses within the work zone will remain open and accessible by foot traffic during construction!

All mail will continue to be delivered as normal during construction.

During construction, the contractor will be responsible for maintaining all garbage and recycling services. Please bring your cans to edge of your property as you normally would on your respective pickup day and the contractor will ensure the containers are picked up.
