A 100-acre site located between Shingle Creek Parkway and Highway 100. The goal is to create a downtown center and signature destination that serves the entire community.

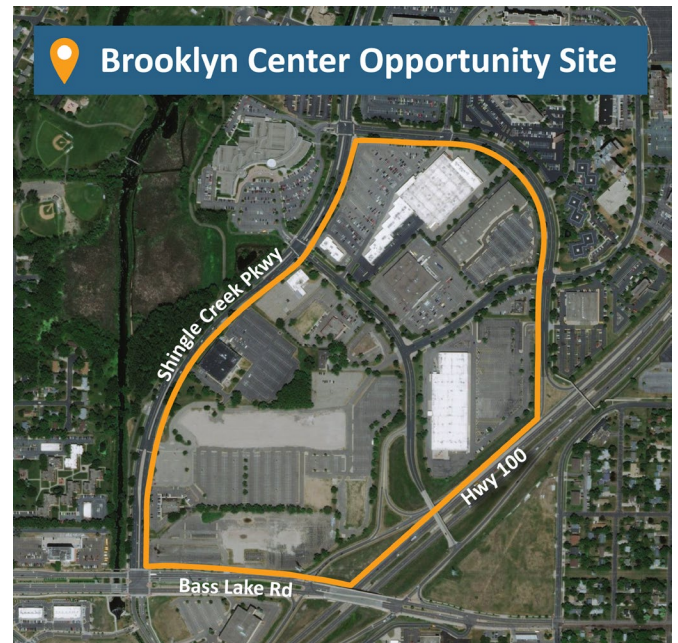
Why Provide Input?
