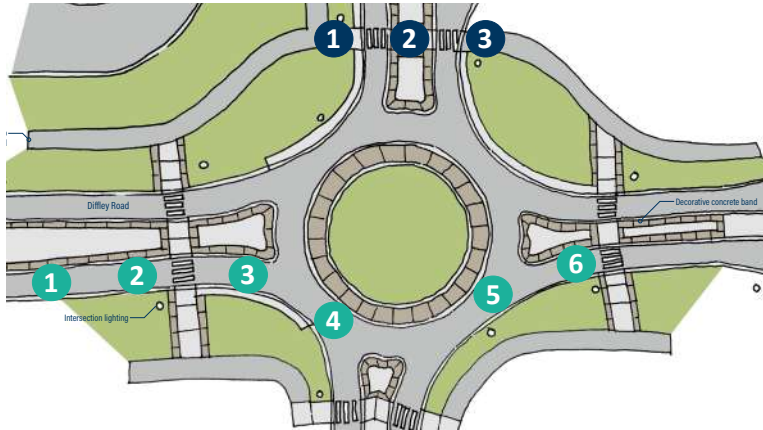


How to Properly Navigate a Roundabout

Driver Instructions

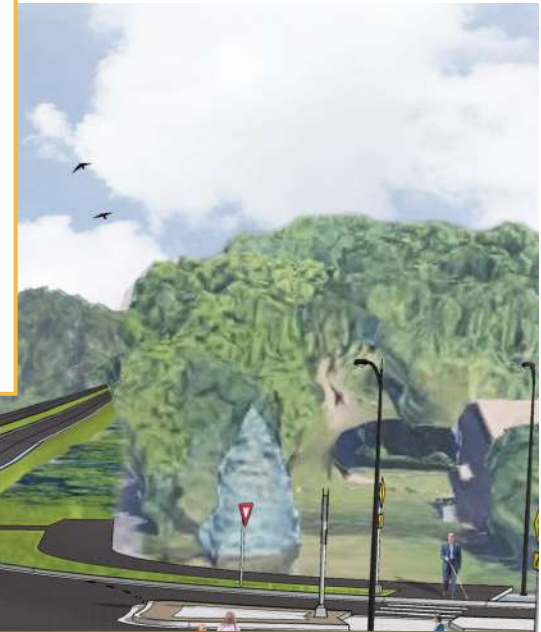
- 1 Slow down as you approach the roundabout.
- 2 Stop for any pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- 3 Yield to oncoming vehicles in the roundabout.
- 4 Find a gap to enter the roundabout.
- 5 Proceed to your exit.
- 6 As you depart, stop for any pedestrians in the crosswalk.



Pedestrian Instructions

- 1 Wait on the sidewalk for a safe gap in traffic.*
- 2 Cross to the raised center island.
- 3 Wait on the island until there is another safe gap in traffic.*

*Before crossing a travel lane always look in the direction of approaching traffic to ensure vehicles are slowing down or stopped.



Benefits A single-lane roundabout is designed to improve safety for all users.

87% fewer pedestrian injury crashes compared to a signalized intersection.

2 pedestrian/vehicle interaction points
vs. **6** interaction points in a traditional intersection

REDUCES CONGESTION DELAYS SERIOUS INJURY CRASHES

Roadway crossing distance is **1/2** the distance of a traditional intersection
