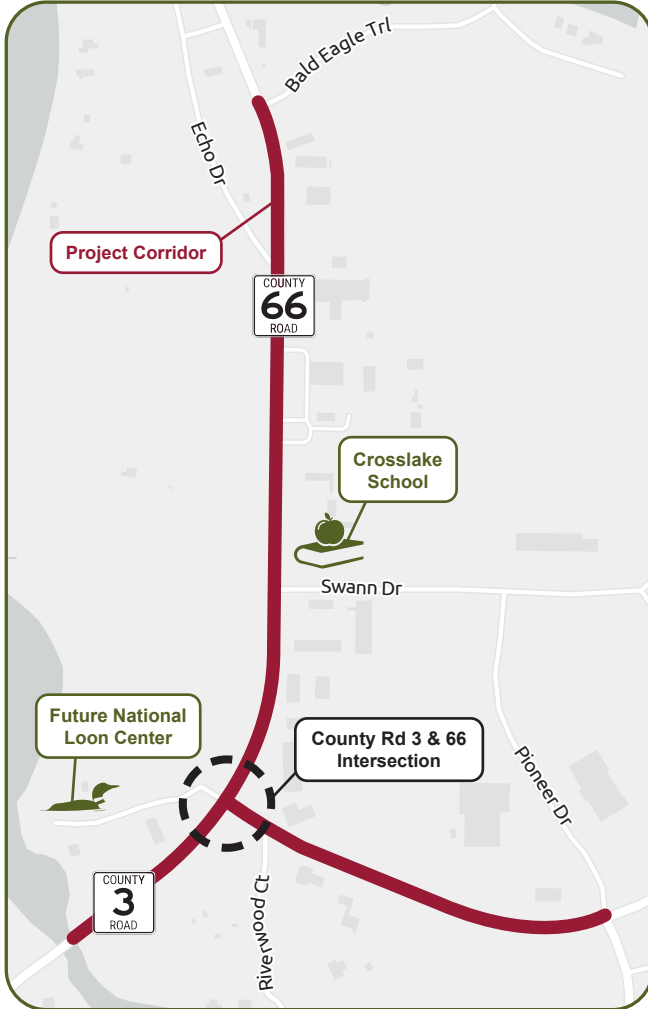


# Crosslake Pedestrian and Intersection Improvements



## Project Overview

Crow Wing County, in partnership with the City of Crosslake, is planning to make improvements to County Road 3 and County Road 66. This corridor has been a topic of conversation for some time, and with the National Loon Center (NLC) set to open in 2024, improvements are needed now more than ever.

This project will align all past, present, and future efforts to establish a cohesive, community-supported vision for the corridor that will be constructed prior to the NLC opening. The proposed improvements include:

- » Safety improvements to the County Road 3 & 66 intersection
- » Pedestrian improvements along County Road 3 to Pioneer Drive and along County Road 66 to Bald Eagle Trail
- » Stormwater treatment improvements to protect water quality

## Project Schedule

This project is currently in the study phase and will be constructed in 2024, before the NLC opens to accommodate the influx of tourism traffic. Below is the full project schedule.

**Preliminary Design:**  
**Dec. 2022 - April 2023**  
*A design is selected and refined.*

**Open House: Spring 2023**



**Final Design:**  
**April 2023 - April 2024**  
*The design is finalized and plans for construction are made.*
