

## ELK RIVER LANDFILL – WASTEWATER CONVEYANCE PROJECT NEWSLETTER NO. 2 – APRIL 27, 2020



Waste Management, Inc., a waste disposal and management company that operates the Elk River Landfill, is undertaking a project, in cooperation with the City of Elk River, to construct a wastewater conveyance system from the Elk River Landfill to the city's wastewater collection system where it can be treated at the City's wastewater plant. The landfill is located at the northern city limits, just west of Highway 169. See the project location map on the back side of this newsletter.

## SCHEDULE UPDATE

The original schedule was to start work on north end of the project in early May in order to keep construction activity away from Meadowvale Elementary School until school was out for the summer. Because of Governor Walz' recent announcement to keep schools closed for the balance of the school year, the Contractor has requested shifting their starting operations to the south end of the project so as to progress from south to north and improve overall efficiency. Therefore, the Great Northern Trail from County Road 1 to Ranch Road will be closed starting May 14, with the intent of having this trail segment back open to the public by July 1.
