Week of June 10

- Crews began installing storm sewer along 200th Street.
- Spot curb and sidewalk removal was completed for all phases of the project.

Week of June 17

- Storm sewer installation along 200th Street will be completed. Crews will then begin installing storm sewer on Chili and Chevelle Avenues.
- Spot curb and sidewalk will be poured on Monday, June 17th. Please refrain from driving on new curb for 7 days. If a piece of new curb/sidewalk is poured in front of your driveway please plan to park on the street in front of your home outside of working hours.
- The streets getting a partial reconstruct will be reclaimed later in the week/early the following week.

Parking, access, and detour information

During construction, the contractor will typically work from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. On-street parking will not be available during working hours. If you need to leave past 7 a.m., you may need to park on another nearby street. Access to driveways will be restored at the end of each work day. If you have a recreational vehicle that you need a place to park during the concrete work the Township has approved parking in the Town Hall Parking Lot off of 197th Street.
