## **Project Update**

July 29, 2019

#### Week of July 22

- Curb and gutter was installed on the Phase 1 Full Reconstruct areas.
- Concrete driveway aprons were installed throughout these areas as well.

#### Week of July 29

- On Monday access will be restored to driveways.
- Street grading will begin early in the week on the Phase 1 Full Reconstruct areas.
- Paving of the first 2-inch pavement layer on the Phase 1 Full Reconstruct areas and driveways is scheduled to occur later in the week. The asphalt will typically be installed at temperatures between 275° and 350° F. Therefore, please have children stay away from the asphalt until it cools, which will be after it's rolled the same day.

Please avoid parking on 200<sup>th</sup> Street west of California, Chili Avenue, Chevelle Avenue, and Chesterfield Way throughout the entire week while they are grading and then paving. During the paving process, access will be reestablished once the asphalt has been rolled and cooled down. If you need to drive over the fresh asphalt, please keep your speed low to avoid spinning your tires and harsh turning motions.

Restoration of the boulevards will begin the week of August 5<sup>th</sup>.

#### Parking, access, and detour information

During construction, the contractor will typically work from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. On-street parking will not be available during working hours. If you need to leave past 7 a.m., you may need to park on another nearby street. Access to driveways will be restored at the end of each work day except during the concrete work. If you have a recreational vehicle (boat, camper, etc.) that you need a place to park during the concrete work, the Township has approved parking at the Maintenance Facility located at 2577 Vermillion River Trail. Please park in the southwest corner of the Maintenance Facility Parking Lot. Please register your name, number, and license plate at Town Hall prior to parking at the Maintenance Facility in case the Township needs to get in contact with you. You may also park in the Town Hall Parking Lot off 197th Street prior to July 31. All vehicles must be cleared out of the Town Hall Parking lot by July 31.
