
## Project Background

#### Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)

- Streets and utilities are analyzed based on condition
- Identify neighborhoods in need of reconstruction
- Information is used to develop the 5 year CIP

# Existing Conditions

Deteriorating pavement
Drainage issues
Watermain breaks
Aging lift station
Broken/blocked sewer



#### Trees

- Tree Study
- Recommendation



- No Trees in Right of Way
- Resident Tree Program



# Proposed Improvements

- Sanitary sewer replacement
- Elimination of lift station
- Watermain replacement
- Storm drainage improvements
  - Storm sewer replacement and extension
  - Stormwater treatment facilities (basins)


# Street Reconstruction

  - City Standard is 28-32 feet
