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Project Overview

As you may know, the City of Fergus Falls has been working to revitalize the downtown area. After years of work, the City is excited to commence the Downtown Riverfront Improvements Project – Phase 1. The improvements of this project will take place in the parking lot on the north side of the Otter Tail River and the area of Court Street adjacent to the parking lot. Throughout the course of the summer the southernmost area of the parking lot will be converted into a multi-use gathering space and pedestrian facilities including the following: a market structure, river overlook, entertainment area, and restrooms. The northern part of the project will have a reconfigured parking area. Project layouts can be viewed on the project website listed on the reverse of this page or attached to the project safety fence.



Project Timeline

Construction activities have been focused on the south half of the parking area where the market structure will be placed. Removals of trees, curb and gutter, and other miscellaneous items took place from 6/9-6/11.

Due to existing unsuitable soils beneath the market structure, a large amount of material is being removed and replaced with engineered fill. This will provide a solid foundation for the market structure. Building excavation will continue over the next few weeks.

Private Utility Work

Private utility work will be happening on the north side of the parking lot area. Otter Tail Power and telecom companies will be rerouting utility lines and will do their best to minimize the area needed to complete their work.

Detour and Access

During construction, access through the construction zone will be limited depending on the construction activity taking place. Local traffic should obey road closed signs and find alternate routes around the active construction zone.

Garbage Pickup

Garbage and recycling collection will continue its regular schedule during construction. During times when the garbage truck is unable to access your receptacles, the contractor will label and move them to an accessible location for pickup and return them to you after collection.



Construction Safety

Work Area

It is very common on these types of projects that area residents become quite curious about the work the Contractor is performing. We ask that you please be respectful of and stay well clear of construction zones. Many hazards and dangers exist from heavy machinery, trenches, loose material, confined spaces, hot asphalt, etc. and often are not recognizable by the general public. The Contractor has responsibility to ensure safety on the project and within the construction area. Any direction from the Contractor regarding safety must be heeded; likewise, if you observe an unsafe condition, please report it to the Construction Representative immediately.
