Overview

The City of Fergus Falls has undertaken a continuation of the Downtown Riverfront Improvements Project. This project will be in the parking lot east of the market pavilion. This project will include the construction of a splash pad, restroom, decorative concrete, utilities, and landscaping that is meant to continue the ideas behind the market pavilion project and create additional public spaces.

Landscape

Starting **Monday, March 27,** crews will be removing trees along the south edge of the project. Many of the existing trees are undesirable or unhealthy which lead to the forestry decision of removing all of the trees. Additional trees will be replanted through the project in the spring of 2024.

Sconstruction Updates

The south half of the parking lot will be closed for approximately 1 week during tree removal to allow for adequate space and safety of the public. Barricades will be placed on Friday, March 24 around the closed area.
