Comment Summary

Attendees were able to submit ideas and feedback in several different ways. There was a chart where attendees could place dots on their preferred priorities, anonymous comment cards, an area where attendees could write ideas on notecards, and several maps where attendees could draw on ideas for bike and pedestrian pathways. Project staff were also present to answer questions and field ideas from attendees. The main topics of discussion included traffic & congestion, fiscal responsibility, and safety.

General Safety

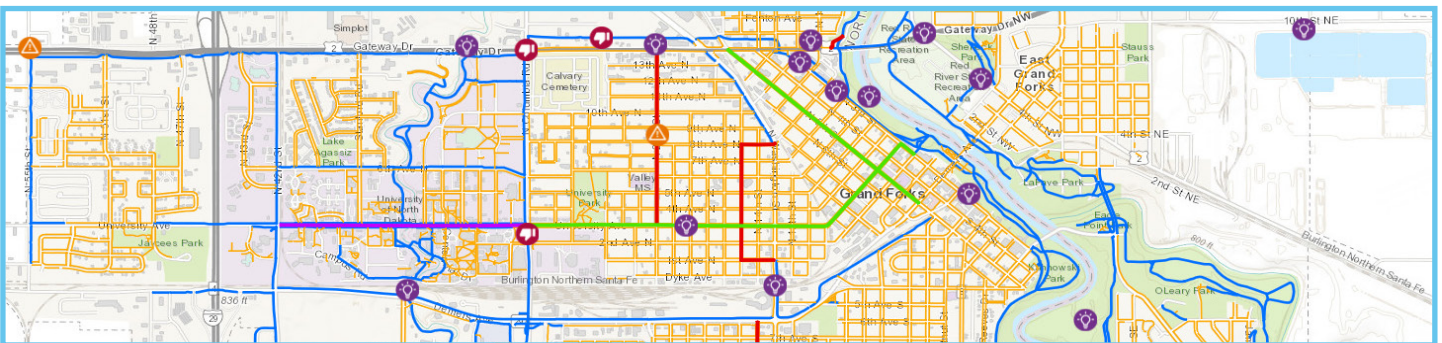
- Concern about sharing the roads with vehicles
- Priority should be set on improving safety while biking and walking
- Support for separate paths for only bicyclists and pedestrians
- Safety issue raised with minors using bicycle paths to recklessly drive golf carts

Traffic & Congestion

- Fear that roadways are too congested to ride bicycles safely
- Worry that construction of bicycle infrastructure on roadways will cause more traffic congestion
- Support for expansion of paths on to county road systems

Fiscal Responsibility

- Apprehension about the cost of any changes made to roadways for bicycles
- Worry about the direction of funds intended for vehicle infrastructure being redirected to bicycle infrastructure
- Concern with the use of funds that could be used for other improvements
