## **Project Update**

During the week of October 10<sup>th</sup>, crews continued sewer main installation on Main Street. Crews also began watermain installation on the north end of Main Street.

During the week of October 17<sup>th</sup>, crews will continue watermain installation heading south on Main Street. Private water and sanitary service connections will also begin. The construction of storm sewer may also begin. If so, this work will start on the south end of main Street and progress north.

ATTENTION TO ALL RESIDENTS ON TEMPORARY WATER: Over nights extended periods of time when water usage is limited, please allow one of your faucets to run slightly. (You will not be charged extra for this water usage). This will help prevent the temporary line from freezing as overnight temperatures drop. Continue this until the temporary service is no longer in use

**Reminder:** Once utility installation starts, there may be intermittent short-term water service interruptions. You will be contacted prior to any planned shut-downs.

If this ends up being the case, the road, driveways, and sidewalks will be returned to a drivable and maintainable gravel surface over the winter and then paved early next spring.
