

# 2019 Street Improvements Project Update



May 03, 2019

## Week of April 29

The contractor began work on Monday April 29<sup>th</sup> by removing the existing blacktop, sidewalk and driveways, on Main Street from Lincoln to Park and on Park Street from Main to Belmont. The contractor then began utility work on Main Street by replacing the sanitary sewer and installing new watermain. Temporary mailboxes were installed for affected residents on Main Street. These temporary mailboxes are labeled and are located on the south side of Lincoln Street, just east of Main Street.

Midco Communications began & completed private utility work on the west side of Main St.

CenterPoint Energy's contractor, Michels, began gas main relocation work on Main & Park Streets. This work is anticipated to be completed and restored by early next week.

## Week of May 6

Sanitary sewer & watermain utility work will continue along Main Street and may continue onto Park Street. Storm sewer installation will follow this work.

## Parking and Access information

The road is closed to through traffic and only residents residing on that block should be utilizing the roads under construction. During the day, construction may inhibit any access where the contractor is currently working. A dirt road will provide access to residents by the end of each day on each block that is under construction.
