



## City of Hampton 2019 Street & Utility Improvements July 17, 2019

### CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

O'Malley Concrete is scheduled to begin pouring the concrete curb and gutter, followed by concrete driveways on all stages of the project beginning on Friday, July 19 (weather permitting). Please note that this work may be postponed until Monday, July 22, if rainy weather occurs this week.

Please have your vehicles out of your driveway by 7 am on the date above.

The contractor will begin with the concrete curb and gutter. After that is completed, all properties will have a concrete driveway apron installed. Existing concrete driveways will have the rest of their driveway installed as well, while asphalt driveways will be completed at a later date. All of this concrete work is expected to take approximately 4 days to complete, weather dependent.

While the concrete is hardening, there will be no access to your driveway. Access is anticipated to be restored after the concrete has hardened, which typically takes about 7 days.

Parking will not be allowed in the project area during working hours (7 am to 7 pm). Please utilize alleys, if available, and adjacent blocks to park your vehicles. If you elect to park on the street overnight, please stay away from the concrete and have your vehicle moved by the morning.
