








Summary of Improvements


- 1st Street NE, 1st Ave NE & 2nd Ave NE
 - Street Reconstruction
 - Pavement, Driveways and Curb & Gutter
 - Sidewalks
 - Replaced existing locations
 - Extensions along 2nd Ave NE
 - ADA Compliance
 - Sanitary Sewer & Services
 - Watermain & Services
- Alley: Center Ave to 1st Ave NE between 1st St and Main
 - Storm sewer extension, roof drain connections & concrete pavement



Proposed Conditions: 1st St NE & 1st Ave NE




Proposed Conditions: 2nd Ave NE

Special Assessments

- Example Lot 200 1st Street NE (2nd Ave NE Project Area):
 - Street, Sidewalk: 120' feet of side frontage (50% Deduction)
 - Sanitary & Water Service

Special Assessments

- 23 Properties
 - 8 Assessments are higher than preliminary estimate.
 - Alley Assessments (6) increased due to scope change
 - 15 Assessments are below preliminary estimate.
- Specific notices mailed to each individual property.
- Detailed Final Assessment Roll available




Special Assessment Payment

- Options for payment:
 - Prepayment
 - Full Payment to City within 30 days (June 23rd)
 - Certified to 2022 Taxes
 - Proposed: 15 Years, 3.0% interest
 - If paying off in full at later date, do so prior to November 15th of given year to avoid being charged interest for following year
 - Deferment Options:
 - Homestead property owner 65 years or older, retired by virtue of perm/total disability, or those in active military service
 - If interested, call City Hall
