

**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A FEDERAL BUILD GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE
HIGHWAY 14/NORTH 3RD AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION**

WHEREAS the City of Marshalltown completed a study of the Highway 14/North 3rd Avenue corridor in 2018; and

WHEREAS, in coordination with the Iowa Department of Transportation, the City of Marshalltown has been planning improvements to occur along the corridor in calendar year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved a contract with Bolton and Menk on March 23, 2020, for the preparation of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) grant program; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for the reconstruction project is \$8.1 million, with the Iowa Department of Transportation committing \$1 million towards the cost of the reconstruction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA, an application for a \$7.1 million BUILD grant is hereby supported and authorized to proceed.
