

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO SUBMIT TO THE US DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION A REBUILDING AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND EQUITY (RAISE) GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the US Department of Transportation (DOT) established the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant Program and has announced funding availability under said Program for transportation infrastructure grants; and

WHEREAS, the City is an eligible applicant with a proven track record of successfully implementing Federal funding from the DOT; and

WHEREAS, the City accepted the Highway 14 Corridor Study in 2018 which identified the improvement of the corridor as a priority; and

WHEREAS, the project total for the 2022 application is estimated at \$28.345 million dollars, of which the City is proposing a RAISE grant of \$18.7 million; and

WHEREAS, the City is proposing utilizing local funding and matching funds from the Iowa DOT and Marshalltown Water Works to support \$9.645 million of the project to ensure a competitive application; and

WHEREAS the City Council has reviewed the request and found it to be in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA:

Section 1. The City staff and Mayor is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant Program application for \$18.7 million; and

Section 2. The Council hereby authorizes staff to accept the award if granted and sign necessary agreements to execute an award.
