





Boulevard Trees

Trees may be removed for one of the following reasons:

- Susceptible to disease or invasive species Ash trees
- Poor condition Dead, dying, leaning, etc.
- Conflict with utilities (Sewer and Water lines)
- Conflict with road construction or grading

Trees that are removed will be replaced with a tree at the end of the project.








Street Maintenance Project Area -**Add Alternates**

- Spot utility repairs
- Milling or reclamation
- Pavement resurfacing
- Pedestrian ramp replacements
- Spot replacement of concrete curb & sidewalk








Project Costs

Preliminary Estimated Project Costs of 2023 Proposed Improvements		
Proposed Street Improvements	\$3,896,000	
Proposed Sanitary Sewer Improvements	\$1,519,000	
Proposed Watermain Improvements	\$1,812,000	
Proposed Storm Sewer Improvements	\$842,000	
Street & Utility Subtotal	\$8,069,000	
Street Maintenance Subtotal (*Add Alternates)	\$786,000	
Total Estimated Project Costs	\$8,855,000	



^{*}Add Alternates may not be included with the final improvements, but will be bid with the rest of the project and included per the direction of Staff and Council depending on bid results and City budget

Project Funding





Overview of Assessment Policy Application

- Avenues Single family residential properties
 - Front foot basis
 - Street assessment capped at \$103.05/foot
 - Utility assessment for 50% of sewer/water service replacement cost
- Streets Single family residential properties
 - 200 Block of 14th Ave N and 15th Ave N assessed for 2nd St N
 - Unit assessments distribute costs one block north and south per policy
- Commercial and apartment properties
 - Lesser of the uncapped policy calculation and a benefit appraisal



Summary of Preliminary Assessments

- 132 total properties to be assessed
- 108 'typical' single family residential properties along avenues
 - Assessments range from \$7,022.00 to \$13,205.00
- 15 single family residential properties along streets
 - Assessments are preliminarily proposed at \$3,478.99
 - With the final assessment roll in March, Staff to propose a reduction to these assessments to account for 2011 assessments and policy cap
- 9 commercial properties or apartment buildings
 - Assessments range from \$2,850.00 to \$76,500.00



Assessments: Summary of Payment Options

- 1. Prepay without interest until July 28*, 2023
- 2. Prepay with interest until Nov. 17*, 2023
- 3. Do nothing -- Remaining balance put on taxes after Nov. 17*, 2023
 - Paid annually over 15 years, interest rate of about 5%*
 - Will impact escrow payments included in mortgage
- 4. Deferred Assessments Pay at a later date. To qualify:
 - Homestead property;
 - Income limit of approximately \$40,000*; and
 - Over 65 years of age, active military, or disability

*Dates, interest rate, and income limit are tentative, to be confirmed in Spring 2023



Project Schedule

- ✓ November 1 Conduct public hearing and consider ordering final plans
- January 17 Approve final plans and authorize bidding
- February 10 Open Bids
- February 21 Order public hearing on assessments
- Early March Neighborhood Meeting 3
- March 21 Public hearing, consider adopting assessments and contract award
- Construction: May to October 2023
 - Construction could possibly start in April if weather conditions allow
 - Final punch list and cleanup items completed in November & Spring of 2024



WHAT IS THE SCOPE OF THE PROJECT?

The project involves street and utility reconstruction improvements including storm sewer, watermain, and sanitary sewer replacement along the following streets:

- . 12th Ave N from Mainstreet to 1st St N
- 14th Ave N from Mainstreet to 2nd St N
- 15th Ave N from Mainstreet to 2nd St N
- 16th Ave N from Mainstreet to 1st St N and 2nd St N to 3rd St N
- 2nd 1 from 14th Ave N to 15th Ave N

A map of the project area is snow below. The project will be constructed over the summer of 2023 by the City's Contractor
