CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

As part of the City of Hopkins 2023 Street & Utility Improvements project, multiple intersections of Mainstreet will be affected starting on **Monday, April 24th**. The intersections include Mainstreet/16th Avenue N., Mainstreet/15th Avenue N., Mainstreet/14th Avenue N., & Mainstreet/12th Avenue N.

This work consists of watermain improvements and will occur over a 2-week period and will require a detour for Mainstreet traffic during the 2 weeks.

The first phase of watermain replacements will occur at Mainstreet/16th Avenue N. & Mainstreet/14th Avenue N. This work will require a detour for westbound traffic. The detour will direct westbound traffic north on 11th Avenue N. to 1st Street N. to 17th Avenue N. with “Local Access Only” to the various Avenues off 1st Street N. This work is scheduled to start on Monday, April 24th. The contractor is scheduled to complete the utility work and pavement restoration by Friday, April 28th.

The second phase of watermain replacements will occur at Mainstreet/15th Avenue N. & Mainstreet/12th Avenue N. This work will require a detour for **BOTH** eastbound and westbound traffic. The detour will direct traffic north on 11th Avenue N. to 1st Street N. to 17th Avenue N. with “Local Access Only” to the various Avenues off 1st Street N. This work is scheduled to start on Monday, May 1st. The contractor is scheduled to complete the utility work and pavement restoration by Friday, May 5th.



CONSTRUCTION PROCESS

Advanced warning message boards will be installed during the week of April 17th. That following week, the contractor will install traffic control devices as well as the traffic detour and detour signage.

The contractor will then conduct the roadway removals and watermain connections. After the connections have been made, the contractor will install the new roadway sections and pave the roadway with new asphalt pavement.

The watermain connections will require watermains to be shut down during the connections. Properties will be notified in advance of the water outages with dates and times. The project team will try to minimize any disturbances to businesses along Mainstreet as it pertains to water outages.

The watermain connections will be a 2-phase, 2-week process. Please see “Project Location & Detour Map” portion of this newsletter.



ACCESS & PARKING

During Phase A, westbound traffic will be detoured to 11th Avenue N. to 1st Street N. to 17th Avenue N., and access to local traffic will need to be made from 1st Street N. for any vehicle traveling westbound. Temporary parking restrictions along the south side of Mainstreet from 17th Avenue N. to 14th Avenue N. will also be required to allow space for eastbound traffic during Phase A.

 **ACCESS & PARKING (CONT.)**

During Phase B, **BOTH** westbound and eastbound traffic will be detoured to 11th Avenue N. to 1st Street N. to 17th Avenue N., and access to local traffic will need to be made from 1st Street N. for all vehicles. Temporary parking restrictions along the south side of Mainstreet from 16th Avenue N. to 15th Avenue N. as well as 13th Avenue N. to 12th Avenue N. will also be required to allow turning movements for traffic at both 15th Avenue N. & 12th Avenue N. during Phase B.
