UPCOMING WORK

The City and its Contractor, Northwest, will be making improvements to 9th Avenue S, 10th Avenue S, and 1st Street S during the month of May. These improvements include spot utility work, spot curb and sidewalk replacements, and roadway pavement resurfacing. A map of the project area is included on the back of this newsletter.

Week of April 24

- Gas main work by CenterPoint Energy and Michels is underway and should wrap up by the end of the week.

Week of May 1

- Utility work will begin at the intersection of 9th Avenue S and 1st Street S. This includes sanitary sewer and storm sewer work.

Week of May 8

- Restoration of the 9th Ave S/1st St S intersection up to a gravel surface.
- Hydrant replacement on 1st Street S near 11th Avenue S.
- Spot concrete curb and sidewalk removals.

Later in May

- Spot concrete curb and sidewalk replacements.
- Milling of the existing asphalt pavement.
- Installing new asphalt pavement on all streets.
- Striping the roadway.

ACCESS & PARKING

Starting Monday, May 1st, the intersection of 9th Avenue S and 1st Street S will be closed for crews to complete utility work in the intersection. Access to all businesses and residences will be maintained during this work and throughout the project, but please use alternate routes until the intersection is open again, later in May.

Parking will not be allowed near 9th Ave S and 1st St S during the first week in May, and then No Parking signs will be posted throughout the project area later in May. In general, parking will be restricted or not allowed within the project area during the month of May, so please plan accordingly.
