SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

The final interest rate for the Special Assessments has been determined to be 5.685%. Payments can be made without interest until July 31, 2024. Payments can be made with interest between Augst 1 and November 15, 2024, before going on property taxes to be paid over 15 years with interest. DROJECT SCHEDULE

The following is an overview of the upcoming phases of the project schedule, and a phasing map is provided on the last page of this newsletter.

Early June

- Concrete work will occur on Phase 1A including curb & gutter and driveway aprons.
- The intersection of 7th Ave & Minnetonka Mills Rd is now open to traffic with one layer of pavement.
- Utility work will continue on Phase 1B along 7th Ave N south of 1st St N with sanitary sewer, watermain, and storm sewer.

Later in June

- The first layer of asphalt will be paved on Phase 1A.
- Restoration work behind the curb will begin on Phase 1A including concrete sidewalk and turf.
- Utility Work will wrap up on Phase 1B and roadway reconstruction will begin.
- Phase 2 will begin after school is out (Mid-June but no earlier than June 10). The intersection of 8th Ave & Minnetonka Mills Rd will be closed to traffic for an extended period during this phase.
- Phase 3A will begin around the same time as Phase 2 starts and will be substantially complete about 4 weeks after the pavement is removed.
