Overview

The City of Baxter is undertaking a construction project to install city utilities and improve the city streets and trails on Foley Road from Highland Scenic Road to Elder Drive and at the Isle Drive and Forthun Road intersection. The project includes the installation of the sanitary sewer, watermain, storm sewer, street and trail construction, and mini-roundabout.

Dates

R.L. Larson is planning the week of June 13th to June 17th to begin crushing the removed pavement and curb to produce aggregate base, class 5 to be used when constructing Foley Road. The crushing operation will be located on Foley Road east of Knollwood Drive. On Monday, June 13th pavement reclaiming on the west end and east end of the project on Foley Road will begin, this is the process of grinding the existing pavement and aggregate base into an aggregate base to be used on Foley Road.

Grading will continue of Isle Drive with excess sand material being hauled and placed on Foley Road in the area of the future Inglewood Drive extension.

Private utility companies will be relocating their gas and communication lines at the Isle Drive mini roundabout.

Access

The Contractor has planned working hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. During underground utility installations pipe is planned to be constructed until 7:00 p.m. and backfilling of trenches completed thereafter.

Local traffic will be allowed to use the affected streets to gain access to businesses and their homes during construction. There may be periods when you will not have access to your driveway when utility trenches are open directly in front of your property. The Contractor and Inspector will coordinate with property owners when access will be limited to their property.

The Contractor will work with the postmaster to establish temporary locations during construction. Temporary mailboxes for Foley Road residents have been relocated to Timberlane Drive between Knollwood Drive and Park Street. Temporary mailboxes for residents/businesses on Isle Drive and Forthun Road will be located on Grouse Drive.

Access will be maintained for emergency vehicles.

Construction

It is very common on these types of projects that area residents (especially children) become quite curious about the work the Contractor is performing. We ask that you please be respectful of and stay well clear of construction zones. Many hazards and dangers exist from heavy machinery, trenches, loose material, confined spaces, hot asphalt, etc. and often times are not recognizable by the general public. The Contractor has responsibility to ensure safety on the project and within the construction area. Any direction from the Contractor regarding safety must be heeded; likewise if you observe an unsafe condition please report it to the Darin immediately.

Weekly construction meetings will be held when construction begins. Meetings will be held each Wednesday at 2:00 p.m. Weekly construction meetings will be held on site and are open to property owners. If there is inclement weather meeting will be held at the Baxter Public Works Facility.

Service Line Connections

New sewer and water will be constructed on Foley Road near the extension of Inglewood Drive. Sewer and water services will be constructed to your property line as part of the city project. Homeowners will be responsible for hiring a contractor to abandon or remove the existing septic system and make the sewer and water connections between the property line and the house. Homeowners will have five years from project completion to connect their house to city sewer and water services. Attached please find a current list of excavating contractors who are licensed and registered in the City of Baxter to complete this work.

Private Improvements in Right-of-Way

If you have improvements such as landscaping, retaining walls, shrubs, bushes, flowers, sheds, irrigation systems, etc. in the right-of-way, it is not the contractor's responsibility to work around them. The property owner is responsible for securing these private improvements and moving them if necessary, to allow the project to be constructed. Neither the contractor nor City is responsible for damages incurred to private improvements in the right-of-way. Any underground improvements, such as irrigation lines and heads, dog fences, etc., should be located and marked so they are readily visible.
