 - Minor delays









This summer the City of Jordan is undertaking a construction project to improve and sustain infrastructure at several locations this summer. The following project areas are to be included in the 2021 Infrastructure Improvement's Project, also as shown in the map on the next page. In <u>brief</u> <u>summary</u>, the work entails:

- Lowertown Area & East Street Resurfacing: The project includes replacing the upper layer of the pavement section across city streets north of Highway 282 and west of Highway 21. East Street between TH 282 and First Street will also be resurfaced.
- Downtown Parking Lot & Alley Construction: The City is paving an alley and installing a new parking lot between Broadway Street (TH 21) and Mill Street, a ½ block south of First Street.
- Railroad Surfacing at 3rd Street: Union Pacific Railroad plans to install new surfacing material at the tracks on 3rd Street, <u>similar to</u> work performed by Union Pacific one block north at 4th Street in 2020.

Project Informational Meeting

Favorable bids for the work were received by the City in March and the City Council will be contracting for the project in April. Once a contractor is on board, a schedule will be requested from the contractor and distributed to the adjacent residents in a follow up newsletter.

An informational meeting has been scheduled to discuss the information provided with this newsletter and answer any questions. The meeting will be held:

There are no special assessments for the street resurfacing work. Special assessments are proposed for the alley work. Owners of property to whom special assessments apply have received an additional notice.







Jordan Area Construction Projects



2021 Hwy 282 Reconstruction



- Urban reconstruction from East St to Lydia Rd for traffic calming
- Construct curb and gutter and other drainage improvements
- Construct 10 ft paved multi-use trail from Lydia Rd to East St
- Replace sidewalk from Mill St to East St for ADA compliance
- Replace retaining wall with modular block wall
- Construct WB Hwy 282 right-turn lane at Pueblo Ave 4/6/2021 mndot.gov

Tentative Construction Schedule

- Start in 2nd or 3rd week of April
- Complete work by end of October
- Work will be done in three stages:

Stage 1: Mill St to Lydia Rd reconstruction Mid-April to Mid-JuneStage 2: Lydia Rd to CR 79/Baseline AveMid-June to Mid-AugStage 3: CR 79/Baseline Ave to Hwy 13Mid-Aug to Mid-Oct

• All dates subject to change due to weather, unforeseen conditions, etc.

Traffic Impacts and Access

• Paving method requires full closure of Hwy 21 each construction stage



Access will remain to homes, businesses, etc. at all times
 Stage 1 closure may require you to park behind house or on side street

If you live on Hwy 282 within active construction stage, use north/south roads for access


Access may not be paved, special accommodations can be made Please use caution and drive carefully through the work zone
