

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

The Contractor is scheduled to start resurfacing work on the street in front of your home soon.

The contractor is currently scheduled to complete milling of the roadways in Lowertown Area **July 7th -9th**. Residents will be able to drive on the milled surface. After milling, the contractor may complete some minor patching on portions of the street before paving back a new layer of asphalt. **Paving is expected to occur within a few days of the street being milled.**

On-street parking will not be allowed while the contractor completes the resurfacing work. Note that temporary no parking signs will be installed on the blocks the contractor intends to complete work on. Please do not park on these streets during working hours (7am to 7pm).

During the paving process, access will be maintained only for residents accessing driveways. If you need to drive over the fresh asphalt, please keep your speed low to avoid spinning your tires and harsh turning motions. Please anticipate delays while entering and exiting the neighborhood on paving days.

The asphalt will typically be installed at temperatures between 275° F and 350° F. Therefore, please have children stay away from the asphalt until it cools, which will be after it is rolled the same day.

Please note that these dates are weather dependent and can change on short notice.
