Restoration/Cleanup

Upon completion of the remaining resurfacing work, the City and the Contractor will conduct a walk thru of all project areas to identify any remaining work. This includes, but is not limited to, restoration of turf in disturbed areas, repair of any damaged infrastructure, cleanup of debris, etc. This work will likely be completed by the contractor in late summer or early fall. Street Resurfacing Work

The City's contractor intends to complete the remaining resurfacing work beginning August 4th. Resurfacing work is expected to last 3-4 days (weather dependent). This work will include the milling and paving of the following Streets:

- Creek Lane from El Dorado Drive to Sunset Drive
- 3rd Street from Varner Street to Broadway Street
- 4th Street from Varner to Broadway Street
- 5th Street
- 6th Street from Syndicate to Varner Street
- Rice Street from 2nd Street to 4th Street
- East Street from First Street to Second Street

On-street parking will not be allowed on these streets while the contractor completes the resurfacing work. Temporary no parking signs will be installed for more specific guidance. Please do not park on these streets during working hours (7am to 7pm) on the days listed.

Access to driveways will be maintained during the resurfacing work. If you need to drive over the fresh asphalt, please keep your speed low to avoid spinning your tires and harsh turning motions. Please anticipate delays while entering and exiting the neighborhood on paving days.

The asphalt will typically be installed at temperatures between 275° F and 350° F. Therefore, please have children stay away from the asphalt until it cools, which will be after it is rolled the same day.

Please note the above dates are weather dependent and could change on short notice. Please reference the project website (www.jordanmnengineering.com) as these dates approach for any further updates.
