OVERVIEW

The City of Jordan and Jordan School District are working together on a project to improve Sunset Drive, including the addition of two roundabouts and pedestrian crossing improvements to increase safety and efficiency for traffic and pedestrians. The project layout can be found on the other side of this page.

PROJECT UPDATES

- Private utility relocations are currently underway. Private utilities are relocating their existing facilities (communications, power, gas, etc.) in preparation of project construction. Private utilities will be working in the project area throughout April and May. Disturbance is anticipated to be relatively minimal and primarily contained within existing boulevards. There may be some minor lane shifts during this work, but private utilities are require to maintain 2-way traffic on all roads.
- The construction contract has been awarded to S.M. Hentges and Sons from Jordan.
- Construction is planned to start the week of June 2nd.

ACCESS CHANGES

- Starting June 2nd (tentative) Sunset Drive and Hillside Drive from Aberdeen Avenue to east of the High School entrance will be closed to through traffic throughout construction. Motorists will need to use alternative routes to avoid the project area.
- Sunset Drive and Hillside Drive are expected to be reopened to traffic by Labor Day.
- Local access to residential properties, including the Timber Ridge housing development, will be maintained throughout construction via Aberdeen Avenue.
