Re: City of Jordan's 2026 Infrastructure Improvements Project

The City of Jordan is planning improvements to several streets and alleys in the summer of 2026 (please see the map on back side for details). We are reaching out early to keep you informed and to invite your input as we begin field work in the project areas.

A brief questionnaire is enclosed for residents. You can complete it either on paper or online—whichever is most convenient for you. Please submit your feedback by **November 28, 2025**.

The City will be reviewing the existing site conditions and confirming the scope of the project over the coming months. The preliminary project scope generally includes:

Alleys:

- Grading / drainage improvements
- Potential addition of storm sewer (to be confirmed during preliminary engineering)
- Concrete paving of the alley

**Note: Per the City of Jordan's Special Assessment Policies, a portion of the costs to improve an existing gravel alley will be assessed to properties abutting alleys. Further detail and notice of these assessments will be distributed this winter.*

Street Resurfacing

- Resurfacing of street pavement (method to be confirmed during preliminary engineering)
- Spot removal and replacement of deficient curb and gutter segments
- Replacement of concrete pedestrian ramps for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

**Note: Special assessments are not proposed for street resurfacing improvements.*

As part of the preliminary engineering process, some land surveying, drone flights, and geotechnical work will be occurring beginning in late October or early November. These items are used to collect information on the existing conditions of the various project areas. The project team will be reviewing the data collected to confirm the scope of the project over the coming months.

Additional information will be provided as the project matures, including a project open house during the winter of 2026. Notification will be mailed prior to the open house.
