The City of Lake City is undertaking a construction project to improve North 7th Street from Monroe Street to Grant Street. The project includes new street construction, an updated drainage system, and the addition of a trail on the east side of the road. See attached map for the project extents.

The City will also perform electrical upgrades this summer in preparation for the project.

Project Timeline

First steps in the planning process include performing a topographic survey, which has been completed. Additionally, the City also ordered soil borings to understand subsurface conditions. This work was performed at the end of May.

City infrastructure department heads have been meeting with the design team since March on the planning for the project. We are at a point where we have information to share and want to engage those along the project.

Project design will continue through the summer and into fall. The City intends to take bids on the project in early winter 2023 and have construction start in late spring 2023.

Informational Meeting

The City will be hosting <u>Neighborhood Informational Meeting #1</u> on <u>Thursday, June 16th at 5:00 PM. The meeting will be held at City Hall in</u> <u>Council Chambers</u>. An informal presentation is planned. The purpose of the meeting is to provide businesses and residents with an opportunity to view the preliminary plan, provide feedback, and ask questions to the design team.

Information gathered during this meeting will be used when making design decisions while preparing construction plans and specifications.

A second informational meeting is planned for this fall when design is nearly complete.
