Garbage / Recycling Pick-Up and Mail Delivery

<u>Garbage</u>: Lake City Disposal is modifying the pick-up schedule for the construction project. All garbage and recycling pick-up will occur on Fridays (Monday commercial garbage pick-up and Wednesday commercial recycling pick-up times are being suspended while construction is on-going).

If your garbage or recycling has not been picked up, please contact Rob Coughlin and let him know so this can be addressed.

<u>Mail During Construction</u>: Mail delivery for those along North 7th Street and Willers Court will be suspended during construction starting on May 1st. The postmaster has agreed to hold everyone's mail for pick-up. This does NOT apply to Fed Ex, UPS, or Amazon deliveries.

If you live on a side street off of North 7th Street (EXCEPT Willers Court) and you are not getting your mail, please contact Rob Coughlin and let him know so this can be addressed.
