#### **Additional Discussion Topics**

**Temporary Easements:** There are several properties where construction will go beyond the property line onto private property. The City will ask these property owners for a temporary easement to construct the project. We will have a short document that we'll ask these property owners to review and sign. The document will expire at the end of the project. Affected property owners will be contacted individually.

**Irrigation Systems:** Please inform the design team if you have an irrigation system so it can be noted for the contractor and field staff.

**Boulevard Trees:** The City is planning to have boulevard trees planted as part of this project (see proposed spacing and location on the roll plot). Species have been identified and are being finalized.
