Summer 2025 – Fall 2026 – Outreach meetings with business and property owners, stakeholder coordination and planning construction staging

Fall 2026 – Public open house for construction staging, business access, and assessment information

Early 2027 - Project bidding

Spring 2027 – Public open house for additional assessment information and what to expect during construction

Summer 2027 – Construction begins




Elwood Street

- Increased space for pedestrians



- Pedestrian crossing (we want your input!)









Ashburn Area

Improvements Include:


- Addition of curb and gutter
