






#### Study Purpose


Identify future transportation improvements that increase roadway function and safety for all modes of traffic on Belgrade Avenue.

#### Concerns with:


- American Legion driveway (close to Range St)

#### PARKING INVENTORY


Blue = Public parking




- Balance vehicle mobility and property access

- Enhance community character and the downtown environment








**4-Lane Option**


**3-Lane Option** 



**200 BLOCK 3-LANE OPTION** 


