Downtown Prior Lake work update

Staging

- Crews are currently working in **Stage 2**
- Main Ave will be closed beginning September 16

Two-week closure of Main Ave/County Highway 21 begins September 16!

The Main Ave/County Highway 21 intersection will be closed for 1-2 weeks to install new underground utilities at the intersection. During this time, Arcadia Ave will be open for north/south access. After this work is complete, Stage 2 will resume, and Main Ave will remain open for the duration of this year's construction. The Main Ave Closure map outlines available routes for local access!

Progress and Upcoming Work

This week:

- Crews graded 21 from West to Arcadia in preparation for curb installation.
- Storm sewer installation began on at the south leg of the 13-21 intersection.
- Private utilities worked on relocating their services.

Next week:

- Crews will install curb from West to Arcadia
- Crews will begin utility work at the Main/21 intersection on Monday, September 16.
- Crews will begin installing a sanitary sewer bypass near the 13-21 intersection.

Highway 13 work update

Staging information

- **Stage 1** includes Highway 13 from Highway 282 to just east of Vergus Ave
- **Stage 2** includes Highway 13 from just west of 180th St to just west of Fairlawn Ave
- **Stage 4** begins in September 16 weather permitting and includes Highway 13 from Panama Ave 12 to Franklin Trail.

Project update

Stage 1 & Stage 2

This week, crews paved the final layer of asphalt and began striping the roadway. Stage 1 & Stage 2 will reopen Monday morning, September 16!

Stage 4



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Stage 4 will be closed to traffic beginning Monday, September 16. This section will be closed for about two to three weeks (weather permitting) to make drainage improvements. Those who live on Creekside Circle will still have access to their homes by entering the construction area from the south during this time. After drainage improvements are made, this section will reopen for local access and will be paved.
