

13-21 CONSTRUCTION NOTICE Pipe Lining

September 19, 2019

Crews will be performing sanitary sewer pipe lining near the 13-21 intersection in the coming weeks. Here's what you can expect (please note all schedule claims are weather permitting):

- In order to line the sanitary sewer pipe, it must first be drained. To accomplish this, crews will be installing a temporary sanitary sewer bypass pipe beginning Thursday, September 19. This temporary line will run along Evanston Ave south of Dakota St. The temporary pipe will be dug into the ground at driveways so that residents will still have access while the temporary pipe is in place. Residents on Evanston will experience a brief closure of the Dakota St/ Evanston Ave intersection as crews connect the temporary pipe to the manhole. The bypass pipe is anticipated to be operational by Monday, September 23.
- Once the temporary pipe is placed, crews will install a pump and begin routing sewage through the temporary line. This pump will run 24 hours a day. Residents can expect this pump to generate noise while it is running (about the same noise level as a lawn mower).
- After the sanitary sewer pipe is drained, crews will begin lining the existing sanitary sewer pipe by pushing the liner into the pipe with compressed air. This is scheduled to begin Monday, September 23, beginning at 6 a.m. After the lining is in place, crews will flush the system with water. This discharge process causes a strong odor, so don't be alarmed if you experience this odor. *Residents are asked to please run water through all faucets for about 5 minutes to lessen the chance of the odor coming into their home*. This process will last under 24 hours.
- Crews will then transfer sewage flow back to the newly lined pipe, remove the temporary pipe, and restore affected pavement and turf.

This entire process is anticipated to last about two weeks. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you.
