Aging Forward How to navigate a roundabout **GOING RIGHT?** Keep to the right to make a right turn **GOING LEFT OR MAKING A U-TURN?** Keep to the left for a

GOING STRAIGHT?

Use either lane, just don't change lanes in the roundabout!
