Old Crystal Bay Road, from Wayzata Boulevard to 6th Avenue North, is set to be fully reconstructed, widened, with turn lane additions to help improve traffic flow along the corridor. Work includes watermain replacement, storm sewer replacement and improvements, and full reconstruction of the pavement surface. Curb and gutter will be added to portions of the roadway along with sections of a center median and street lighting. Additionally, entrances to school parking areas will be reconstructed to better accommodate traffic flow.

WEEK OF JUNE 11

Traffic control has been set up, removals have been marked, and equipment has been mobilized to being pavement removals on Friday, June 15th. The contractor is intending to finish all pavement removals by the end of the day Saturday. Throughout the project, Old Crystal Bay Road will be closed to thru traffic, but open to all local traffic. Check the site weekly for direction on the best avenues for access to school facilities.



WEEK OF JUNE 18

The contractor will begin with utility removal, beginning at the north end near 6th Avenue North (CSAH 6). As the week progresses, crews will begin utility construction by replacing the existing watermain and storm sewer. This will continue into the following week. The street crew will follow closely behind, removing the existing road subgrade, hauling in new material, and grading the new roadway.
