Old Crystal Bay Road, from Wayzata Boulevard to 6th Avenue North, is set to be fully reconstructed, widened, with turn lane additions to help improve traffic flow along the corridor. Work includes watermain replacement, storm sewer replacement and improvements, and full reconstruction of the pavement surface. Curb and gutter will be added to portions of the roadway along with sections of a center median and street lighting. Additionally, entrances to school parking areas will be reconstructed to better accommodate traffic flow.

WEEK OF JUNE 18

Bituminous pavement removals have been completed throughout the corridor. On Thursday, storm sewer and watermain work will begin starting at CSAH 6 (6th Avenue North) and working to the south. For the next week, the best access to school facilities will be from Wayzata Boulevard, as road reconstruction will begin on Friday again at the north end near CSAH 6 continuing to the south.



WEEK OF JUNE 25

The contractor will begin sidewalk and curb removals throughout the project corridor mainly around school facility entrances. Please use caution and watch for workers when entering and exiting school facilities. Watermain and storm sewer construction will continue from the north end working south, with road construction following close behind.

It is advised to continue accessing Old Crystal Bay Road from Wayzata Boulevard for the week of June 25th as access from CSAH 6 will be temporarily limited while the contractor replaces the road subgrade near this intersection.
