



CITY OF ORONO: OLD CRYSTAL BAY ROAD

June 28, 2018





Old Crystal Bay Road, from Wayzata Boulevard to 6th Avenue North, is set to be fully reconstructed, widened, with turn lane additions to help improve traffic flow along the corridor. Work includes watermain replacement, storm sewer replacement and improvements, and full reconstruction of the pavement surface. Curb and gutter will be added to portions of the roadway along with sections of a center median and street lighting. Additionally, entrances to school parking areas will be reconstructed to better accommodate traffic flow.

WEEK OF JUNE 25

Curb and sidewalk removals were completed in the elementary and high school parking lots. Storm sewer has been constructed from CSAH 6 to the High School and they are making progress to the south on watermain construction. Subgrade replacement on the roadway has been completed from CSAH 6 to the Ice Arena/Ball Park entrance. If you need to access those facilities, please do so from CSAH 6. All other school facilities should be accessed via Wayzata Boulevard for the remainder of this week.

WEEK OF JUNE 25

The contractor will continue with watermain and storm sewer construction through the middle school and high school entrances. Another crew will follow close behind, building the roadway. Additionally, subgrade replacement will take place in impacted areas of the middle school and high school parking lots.

During utility construction, there will be brief closures of middle school and high school entrances. There will always be at least one access point open.

It is advised to continue accessing school facilities from Wayzata Boulevard for the week of July 2nd. Those accessing the Ice Arena or Ball Park, should utilize CSAH 6.
