Old Crystal Bay Road, from Wayzata Boulevard to 6th Avenue North, is set to be fully reconstructed, widened, with turn lane additions to help improve traffic flow along the corridor. Work includes watermain replacement, storm sewer replacement and improvements, and full reconstruction of the pavement surface. Curb and gutter will be added to portions of the roadway along with sections of a center median and street lighting. Additionally, entrances to school parking areas will be reconstructed to better accommodate traffic flow.

WEEK OF JULY 16

Storm sewer work was completed for Phase 2 of the project. Old hydrants and valves were removed. Preparations were made to begin road building of Phase 2 in the coming week. The process will begin Friday and continue into next week between the High School and Elementary School.

If you are accessing the High School, Middle School, Ice Area or Ball Fields – Use CSAH 6. For all other facilities, please continue to use Wayzata Boulevard.



WEEK OF JULY 23

Road building will continue between the Elementary and High Schools. Additionally, utility work may begin across the Elementary School entrance. This would cause a 2-day closure of that access point. When this is more firmly scheduled, we will coordinate that with the school and daycare to keep everyone updated.

During this upcoming week, there will be no way for thru traffic to get from Wayzata Boulevard to CSAH 6 without using the posted detour.

It is advised to access intermediate and elementary schools from Wayzata Boulevard for the week of July 16th. Those accessing the Ice Arena, Ballpark, High School or Middle School, should utilize CSAH 6.
