





CITY OF ORONO: OLD CRYSTAL BAY ROAD

July 26, 2018





Old Crystal Bay Road, from Wayzata Boulevard to 6th Avenue North, is set to be fully reconstructed, widened, with turn lane additions to help improve traffic flow along the corridor. Work includes watermain replacement, storm sewer replacement and improvements, and full reconstruction of the pavement surface. Curb and gutter will be added to portions of the roadway along with sections of a center median and street lighting. Additionally, entrances to school parking areas will be reconstructed to better accommodate traffic flow.

Road construction of the new frontage road began, Xcel installed the new power poles, and utility work began near the Intermediate School and City Hall. Utility work will continue headed south toward Wayzata Boulevard.

Beginning next week, curb and gutter installation will start at CSAH 6 and head south. Curb and gutter will continue into parking lots where old pavement has been removed and will also include a center median. Please use caution when traveling in these areas.

During this upcoming week, there will be no way for thru traffic to get from Wayzata Boulevard to CSAH 6 without using the posted detour due to ongoing utility work and road building. Please consider the following when accessing facilities on Old Crystal Bay Road:

If you are accessing the Elementary School, High School, Middle School, Ice Area or Ball Fields – Use CSAH 6. To access the Intermediate School, use Wayzata Boulevard. To access City Hall, use Kelley Parkway.
