Old Crystal Bay Road, from Wayzata Boulevard to 6th Avenue North, is set to be fully reconstructed, widened, with turn lane additions to help improve traffic flow along the corridor. Work includes watermain replacement, storm sewer replacement and improvements, and full reconstruction of the pavement surface. Curb and gutter will be added to portions of the roadway along with sections of a center median and street lighting. Additionally, entrances to school parking areas will be reconstructed to better accommodate traffic flow.

WEEK OF JULY 30

Curb and gutter was constructed from CSAH 6 to the new frontage road including medians. Watermain and storm sewer construction continued toward Kelley Parkway. Electrical service began being transferred to the new poles. Road grading began at CSAH 6 headed south.

Thank you for your cooperation with traffic flow. The next few weeks will be congested as crews work to finish before the school year begins. Stay tuned for further updates regarding access needs.



WEEK OF AUGUST 6

The contractor will continue grading from CSAH 6 toward the new frontage road. The intention is to pave the base course of bituminous on the north half of the project next week.

The utility contractor will also be wrapping up storm and watermain near Kelley Parkway and the Intermediate School.

Early next week, access to all facilities should come from CSAH 6. There will be construction traffic in this area, so please exercise caution. When paving operations begin, it would be best to switch and utilize Wayzata Boulevard later in the week.
