The 2018 Street Improvements Project includes the reconstruction of various streets, storm sewer, and watermain throughout the City of Orono. This includes milling existing pavement sections and overlaying new bituminous pavement on Vine Place as well as Lyric Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Blaine Avenue. Additionally, mill and overlay work with storm sewer replacement and guardrail installation will be performed on Leaf Street from Bayside Road to Watertown Road and Forest Lake Landing. Work to be completed on West Lafayette Road includes watermain and water service replacement, reclamation of the bituminous surface, and construction of curb and gutter in some areas. Construction activities on Wildhurst Trail and Minnetonka Highlands Lane include storm sewer construction, curb and gutter and guardrail or portions of the roadway, and reclamation of the bituminous surface. Lastly, the northern end of Linden Lane will be realigned with some culvert replacement as well.

WEEK OF AUGUST 13

Water service and storm sewer reconstruction was completed on West Lafayette Road. Storm sewer construction should begin on Wildhurst Trail at the end of the week (7-10 days). Grading on Minnetonka Highlands Lane, Linden Lane and West Lafayette Road could begin late this week or early next to prepare for curb and gutter and paving operations.

WEEK OF AUGUST 20

Storm sewer work on Wildhurst Trail will continue throughout the week (and into the following week) and may finish with stump removal on Forest Lake Landing. Road grading will take place on West Lafayette Road and Minnetonka Highlands Lane to prepare for curb likely the week of the 27th or at the end of the week if things progress quickly. No work scheduled on Linden Lane until West Lafayette Road and Minnetonka Highlands Lane are ready to pave.
