





CITY OF ORONO: OLD CRYSTAL BAY ROAD

August 31, 2018





Old Crystal Bay Road, from Wayzata Boulevard to 6th Avenue North, is set to be fully reconstructed, widened, with turn lane additions to help improve traffic flow along the corridor. Work includes watermain replacement, storm sewer replacement and improvements, and full reconstruction of the pavement surface. Curb and gutter will be added to portions of the roadway along with sections of a center median and street lighting. Additionally, entrances to school parking areas will be reconstructed to better accommodate traffic flow.

WEEK OF AUGUST 27

The base course of asphalt was paved throughout the job. Final course was paved on the school facilities. Striping and signage was added along with topsoil behind the curbs. Final sidewalks were poured and stockpiles were removed from the site.

WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 4

Work will continue throughout the week on trails, utility relocation, grading and ditch cleaning off the paved surfaces. Crews will do their best to avoid major work items during peak traffic times, but please be aware that crews will be in the area.
